

Parent Voice – June 2023

We gather parent and pupil voice twice a year. The results below show the outcomes of the parents' voice collected in June 2023. At the time of the survey, we had 36 pupils on roll. We now have 39, however, we have not collected views from these parents.

Of the 36 surveys, 35 have been returned. The remaining parent will be supported in completing this on parents' evening.

There were two or three questions within the surveys not answered. No reason was given for this.

Questions 7 and 15 were 'yes' and 'no' answers.

Overall, the results were very positive. We have some further work to do, and the action points can be seen at the bottom of this report.

Any other comments you would like to make:

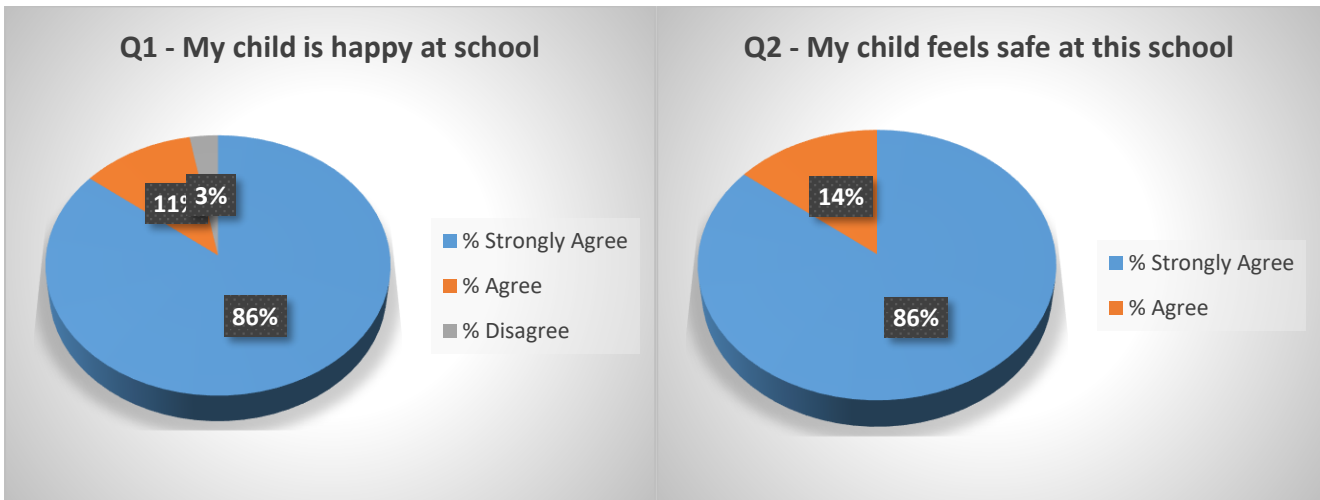
- My son has been to 3 schools – this is the only one he wants to be at, excited to be there. Impact on home is positive.

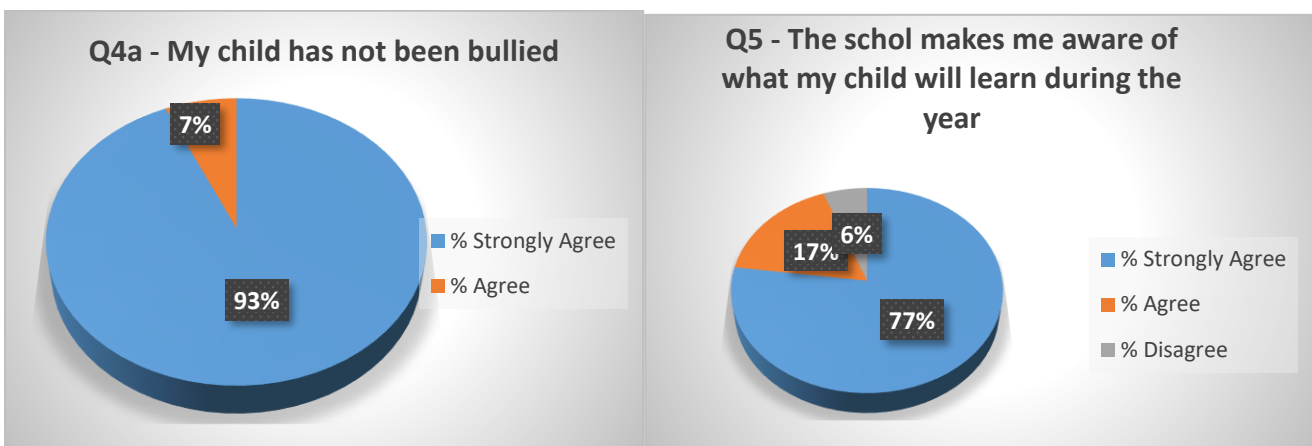
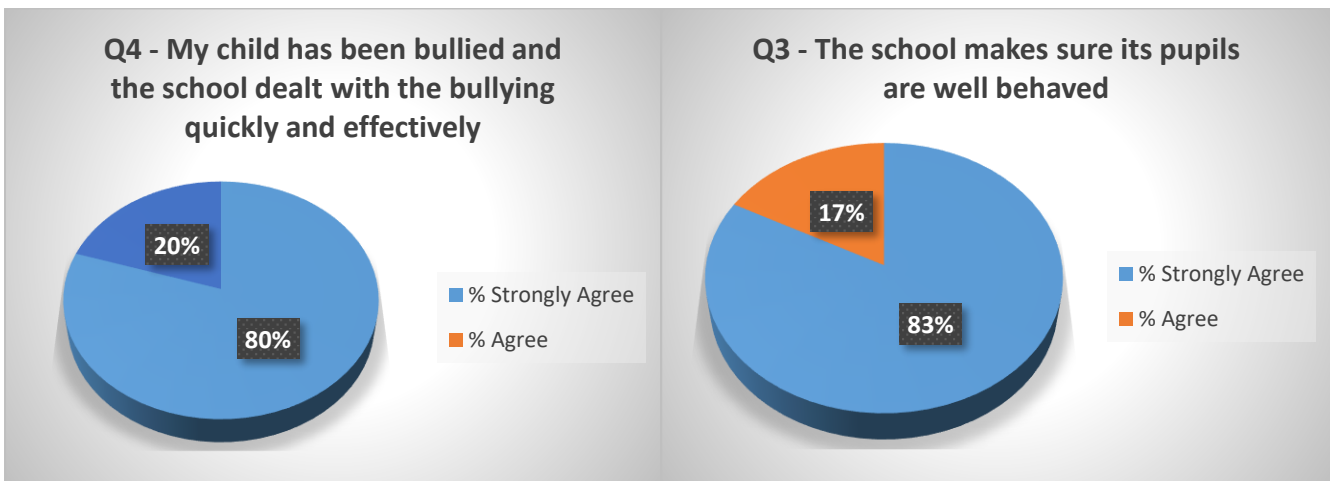

Graphical representation

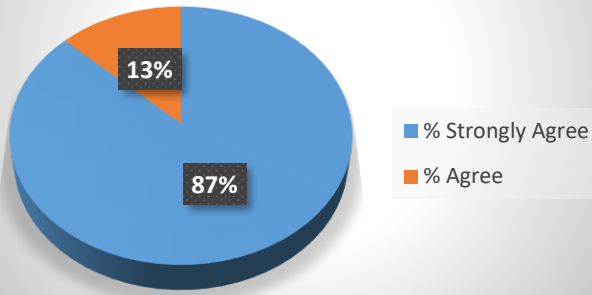


Action: Q1 – 1 parent has disagreed, discuss with parent

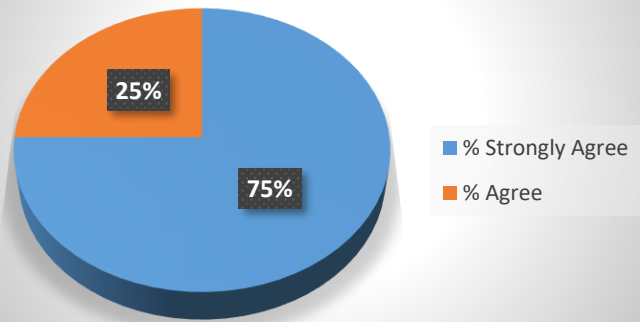


Action: Q5 – ask parents how we can improve this.

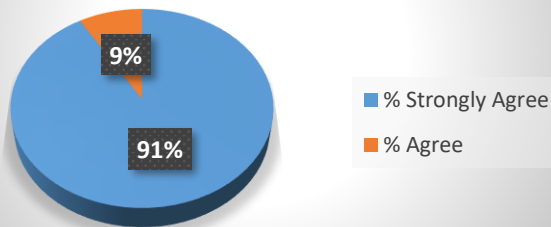
Q6 - When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly



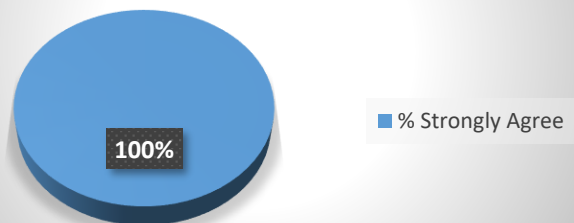
Q6a - I have not had to any concerns to raise



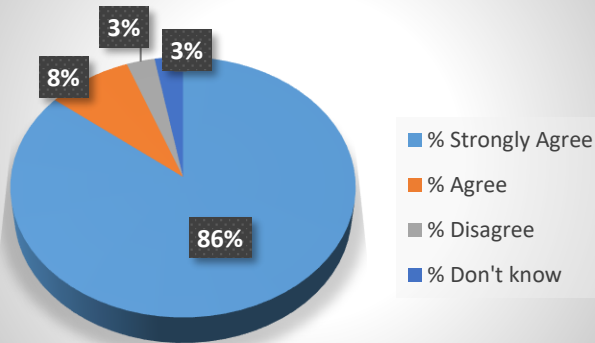
Q7 - Does your child have special education needs and/or disabilities (SEND)



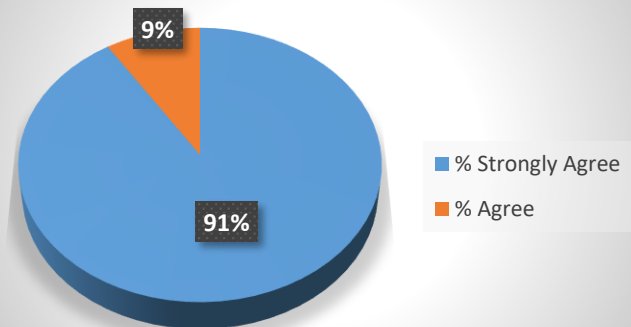
Q8 - When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly.



Q9 - The school has high expectations for my child.

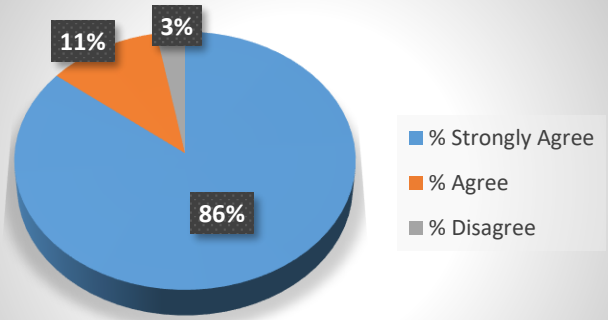
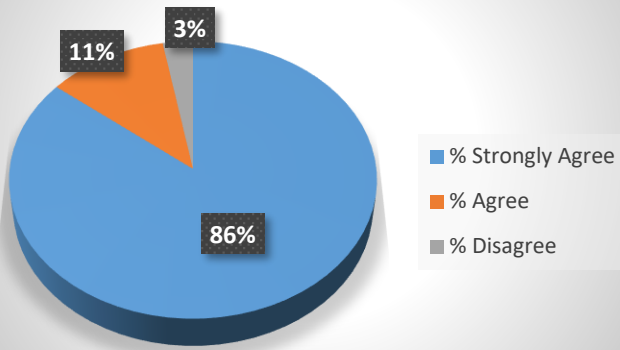


Q10 - My child does well at this school
